

2026 Board of Trustee Elections



Voting Instructions

The Platinum Health Medical Scheme nominations are now **closed**. Platinum Health Medical Scheme members that are in good standing as of Friday, 22 May 2026 are eligible to vote in this election. You will be required to vote for up to five (5) candidates of your choice. Voting will take place at identified voting stations in the North West and Limpopo (Eastern Limb). Voting stations will open at 06h00 and close at 22h00. The links to the **online (web) voting** will be sent on Wednesday, 3 June 2026 at 23h00 in readiness for the vote opening at midnight till 23h59 on Thursday, 4 June 2026.

Voting Procedure

There are **two voting options** in this election. The **online (web) voting** and the **manual voting** at the identified voting stations.

To vote, you need to have the following on hand:

- **ID Card/Green Barcoded ID, Clock Card** that has a photo of the member and ID number visible on it or any legal form of identification e.g. Driver's Licence, to have your details validated against the Voters' Roll.
- **Unique Ballot Paper Number** within your e-mail and/or SMS from the Returning Officer to authenticate yourself when choosing to vote online via web.

Option 1 (Web Voting):

- **Click on the link** on your e-mail on your laptop, smartphone or tablet and authenticate yourself by typing in your **13-digit ID Number**, your **10-digit Platinum Health Membership Number** and your **Unique Ballot Paper PIN** by following the prompts.
- Once you have **successfully authenticated yourself**, you may choose to view the Voting Instructions and CV Booklet containing the biographies of all candidates to make an informed choice when voting.
- When you are **ready to vote**, click on the **"VOTE"** link and vote for up to **five (5) candidates** of your choice from the **list of 38** by clicking on their name(s) and photo(s) and **"SUBMIT"**.
- After submitting your vote(s), you will **receive a vote confirmation** and exit the voting platform.

If you make a mistake before submitting your ballot paper, you can click on the incorrect choice to undo your selection, and select the correct one and submit.

Option 2 (Manual Voting):

Manual voting is scheduled to take place at the **listed voting stations from 06h00 to 22h00**. Again, you will need your ID Card or any form of **formal identification to vote**. Upon arrival at the voting station, you will be:

- Taken to the **"Registration Desk"** to have your name checked against the Voters' Roll and your name scratched off.
- Given your **Ballot Paper** and shown to a booth to make your **choice in secret**.
- Once done, you will be shown to where the Ballot Box is to **deposit your Ballot Paper**.
- **Marked with ink** and shown the exit point and leave the voting station.

If you make a mistake on your ballot paper before depositing it into the ballot box, please raise your hand to ask for help. An Electoral Officer will come to your assistance and resolve whatever problem you may have encountered.
